Looking back on the year 2011 MCCC experienced many changes to the ministry.

That is how our first newsletter for 2012 began this past year, the same statement can be applied for the year 2012. We have lost some of our staff, new therapists have come on board, we have created partnerships with other organizations (CVHF, Crosslink Church), and we have now expanded services to the eastern end of Burke County. We no longer bill Medicaid due to changes in reg-

ulations, the administrative costs, and additional agencies involved in processing. CVHF (Barium Springs) has selected MCCC to be the mental health provider of choice, Crosslink Church in Rutherford College has pro-



vided space for MCCC to offer counseling services until more permanent

space can be found. Two new therapists, Cathy Pasour and Laura Roach have joined the MCCC team bringing new skill sets and interests that will allow MCCC to offer some services we have not been able to provide before.

That was 2012. A new year has already started and new challenges are before us. We will provide more details in later issues of "Centergy". But for now, **THANK YOU**, for the support that you have provided financially and prayerfully this past year.
